1.1 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This device complies with international safety standards.

- Before commissioning, please read the safety instructions carefully and keep
- the operating instructions within easy reach.
- Observe the warnings on the device and in the operating instructions.
- Never allow children to use electrical appliances unattended.

Ambient conditions: Protect the device from moisture and heat and do not expose it to direct sunlight. Open fire sources, such as burning candles, must not be placed on the device. Avoid placing the receiver in areas with insufficient ventilation. Keep a clearance of at least 10 cm above and at least 5 cm from the side of the device, so that the resulting heat can be dissipated without hindrance. Do not place objects filled with liquids, eg. As vases, on the device. Avoid the penetration of foreign bodies and liquids into the device. Do not expose the device to dripping or splashing water.

Power Supply: Only connect the receiver to the power supply after you have completely wired it. Avoid overloading the power outlet, power supply lines or a power supply. This could lead to fire or electric shock. Disconnect from the mains during prolonged absence: If the unit is left unattended for a longer period of time (eg holidays / holidays), you should disconnect it completely from the mains.

Lightning protection: To protect the receiver, switch it off during thunderstorms and unplug the power plug and the antenna cable. This protects your receiver from overvoltage damage. Connecting peripheral devices: Disconnect the device from the mains before connecting or disconnecting the cables to antennas, TV sets and other devices.

Installation: The rubber feet can cause color changes in connection with furniture surfaces. If necessary, place the device on a suitable surface.

Faults: In case of damage to the mains cable or the device, immediately unplug the mains plug from the mains socket. Never try to open or repair the device yourself.

Batteries: Children may take batteries in their mouths and swallow them. Leaking batteries can damage the remote control. If the receiver is not used for a long time, remove the batteries from the remote control.

Use only original parts and accessories: Use only original parts or original accessories from your dealer to prevent damage to your device or injury. 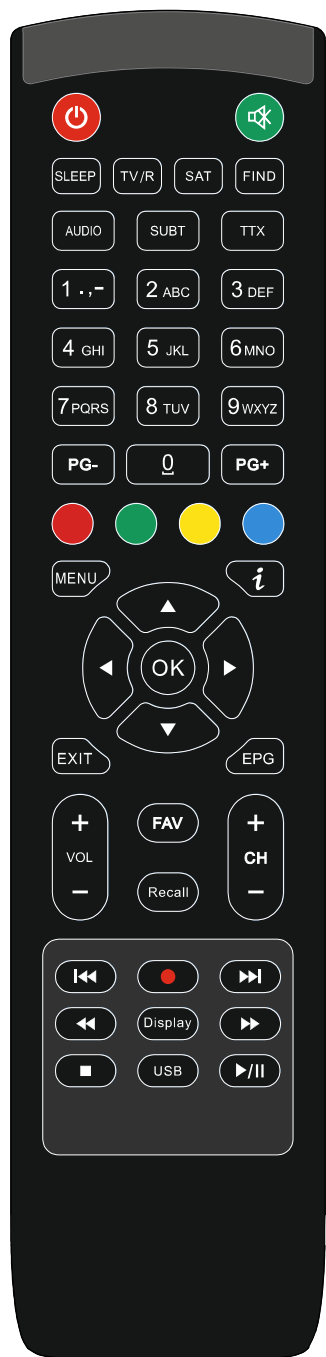

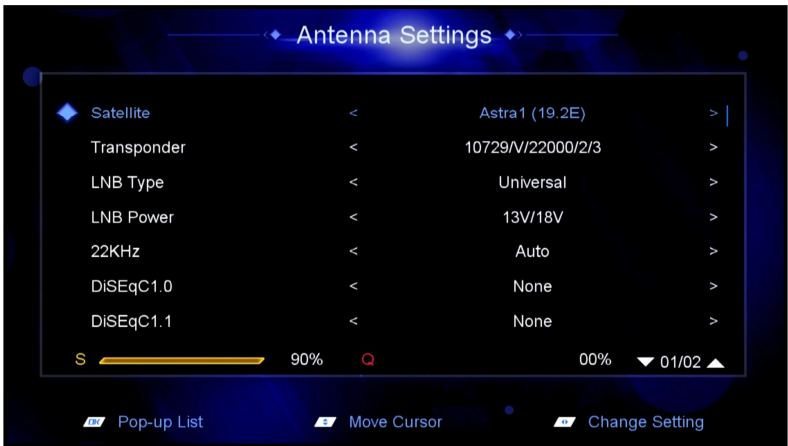
4.1 FIRST INSTALLATION

The FIRST INSTALLATION starts with the first connection of your device. Here you select your menu language. To do this, navigate to the desired language with the ▲ / ▼ buttons and confirm with the OK button (the default is 2 Deutsch). After confirming the menu language, the receiver loads the program list preinstalled by the manufacturer.



5.1 INSTALLATION (ANTENNA SETTING / PROGRAM SEARCH)

To configure your receiver to the correct antenna setting and start a program search, press the button **MENU** on your remote control and navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to the Menu **Installation**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK**. Now navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to the menu item **Antenna Settings**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK**.



You can now scroll up and down with the buttons ▲ / ▼ through the following menu.

Transponder	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your Transponder on which Transponder you want to search your programs
LNB Type	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your LNB-Type: Universal, 9750/10750, 5150/5750, 5750/5150, Unicable A-D, SCD2 A-H, 05150-11475, User Single, User Dual
LNB Power	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your LNB Power: 13V/18V , 13V, 18V, 0V
22 KHz	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ the 22 KHz Mode: Auto (standard), On, Off
DiSEqC1.0	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your DiSEqC settings if you use multiple LNBs and a DiSEqC 1.0 switch: None, LNB1-4, Burst A/B, Autom.
DiSEqC1.1	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your DiSEqC settings if you use multiple LNBs and a DiSEqC 1.1 switch: None, LNB1-16.
Motor	If using an external sat motor/rotor, select your settings with the buttons ◀ / ▶ : DiSEqC 1.2, USALS, None
Scan Mode	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ your Search Mode, What programs you want to search: All Channels, FTA Channels, Scramble Channels, HD Channel, SD Channels, TV Channels, Radio Channels, FTA TV Channels
Start Search	Select with the buttons ◀ / ▶ what Search Mode you want to start: Satellite Search, Multi-SAT Search, Blind Search, TP Search, Multi-TP Search

Press the button **OK** for starting the program search.

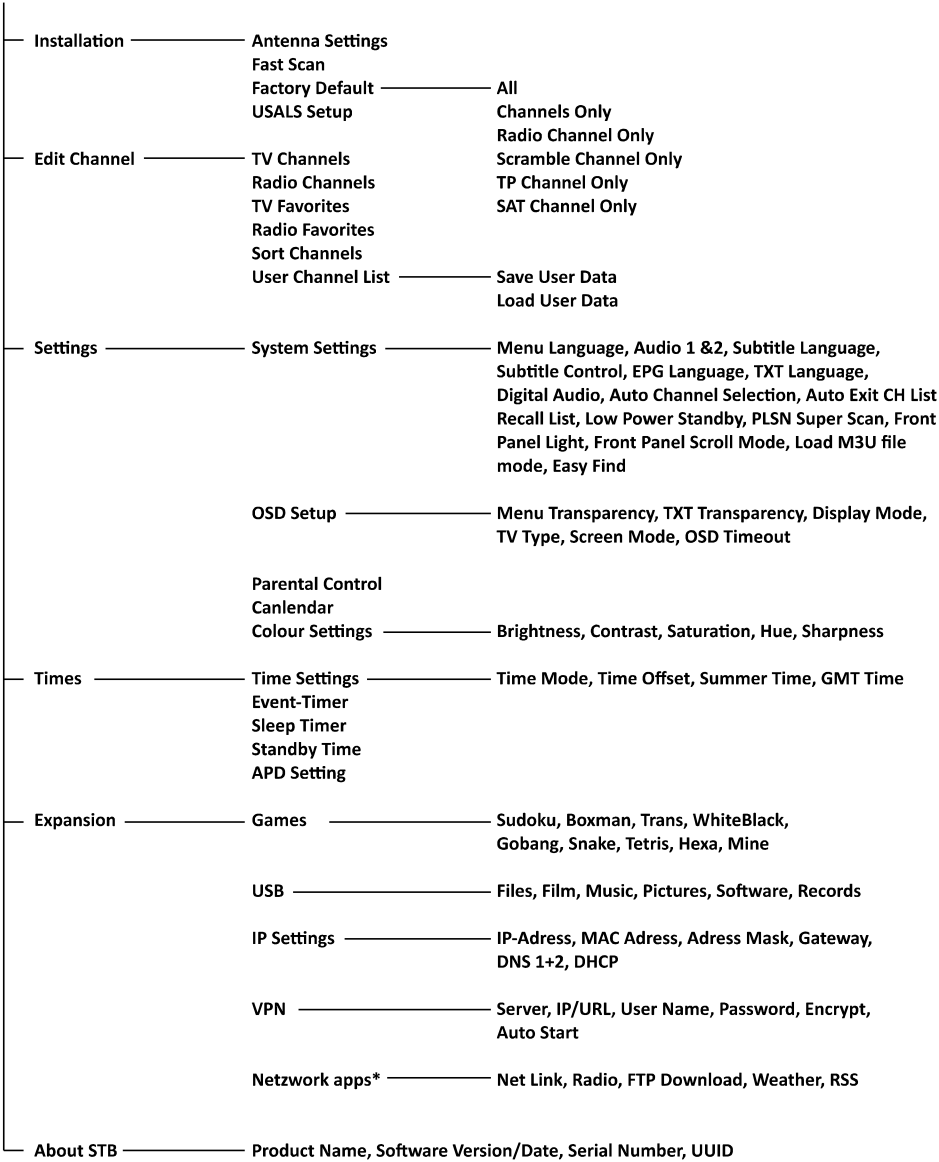
6.1 FACTORY DEFAULT / PIN CODE

To reset your receiver to the factory settings, press the button **MENU** on your remote control and use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to navigate to the menu item **Installation**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK** . Now navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to the menu item **Factory Default**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK**. Use the number keypad of your remote control to enter the password (default password: 0000) and confirm this with the button **OK**. The password can be changed at any time under the menu item **Parental Control**.

ATTENTION *: If you select **ALL**, all settings, satellites, and programs will be deleted. The device restarts and starts with the **FIRST INSTALLATION**.

8.1 Troubleshooting

If you have any problems with this device or with installation, please refer to the corresponding section in the "detailed manual" (which can be downloaded from the manufacturer's website) and read the suggested solutions in the table below.

Problem	Possible Cause	Suggested solution
The device shows no function	The device is not connected to the power supply	Check the power cord and your power connection
	Device is not switched on	Press the POWER switch on the device
"Signal is weak!"	The antenna cable is not connected or is defective	Check the cable connection from your antenna socket or from the satellite system to the device
	Wrong setting (configuration in search)	Set the correct parameters in the search.
No Sound	The audio cable is not properly connected or defective	Check the connection and the connected cable
	The sound is muted	Press the MUTE button on your remote control or continue to adjust the volume higher.
	Wrong audio setting	Select the correct audio channel via the AUDIO button on your remote control.
Channel can not be seen	The channel is scrambled. A scrambled program with the character \$ will be displayed in the station list.	This device is a FTA device and ONLY receives free-to-air programs. Replace the device.
PIN code is not accepted	You have entered an incorrect PIN CODE	Use the MASTER-PIN: 9876
No function of the remote control	The device is switched off or without power	Turn on the device and start the power supply
	The remote control is not aligned with the sensor on the receiver	Point the remote control at the receiver - not at your TV
	Batteries are empty or inserted incorrectly	Check that the batteries are inserted the right way round in the remote control.
The picture stops or you see small boxes	The signal is too weak	If necessary amplify your signal with an amplifier
	The antenna cable is not sufficiently shielded	Replace your antenna cable with a shielded antenna cable
Channels are missing in the program list	At times it happens that frequencies from programs can be changed	Start a new transponder search if you know the new frequency. Otherwise start complete new search.
